





About Brother Luck

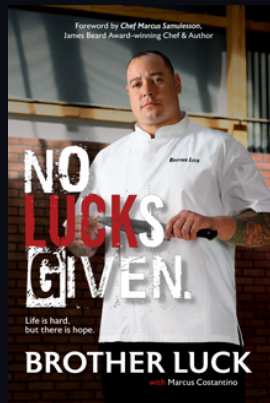
