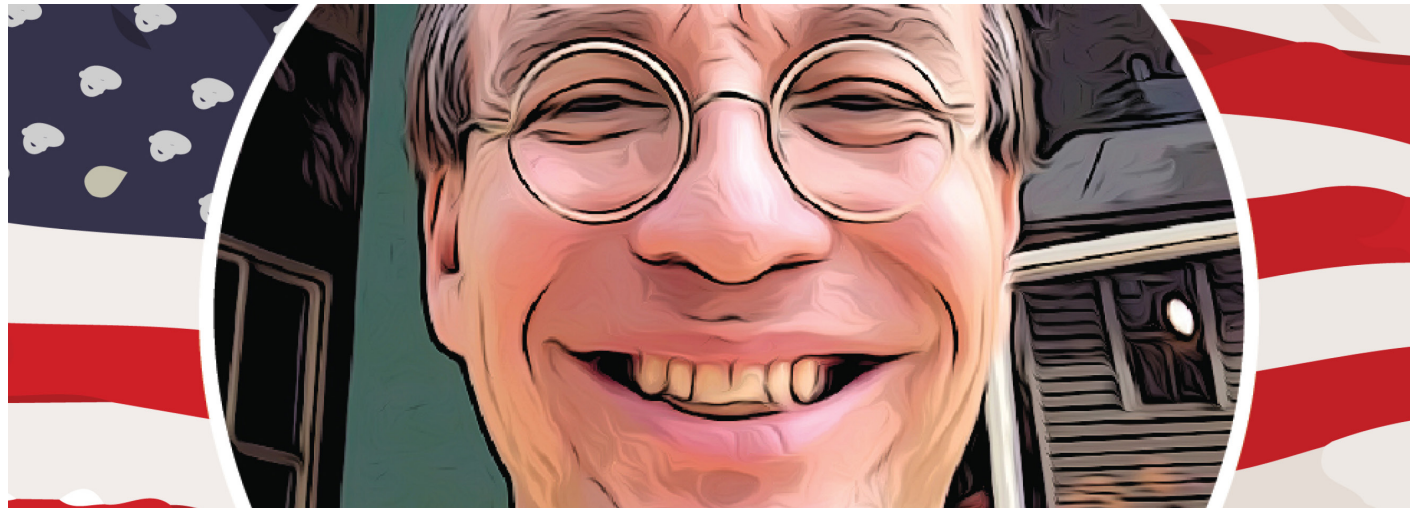

Price: The online conversation has a suggested honorarium of \$500. The in-person dialogue has a fee of \$2,500. And the comedy shows cost \$5,000 if within 250 miles of Washington, D.C. The comedy performance increases to \$6,500 if the school is greater than 250 miles from our nation's capital.
